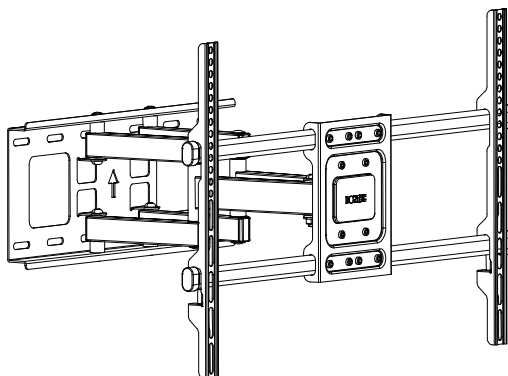

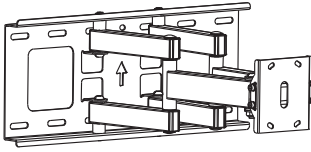
This TV mount must be securely attached to the vertical wall. If the mount is not properly installed it may fall, resulting in possible injury and/or damage.

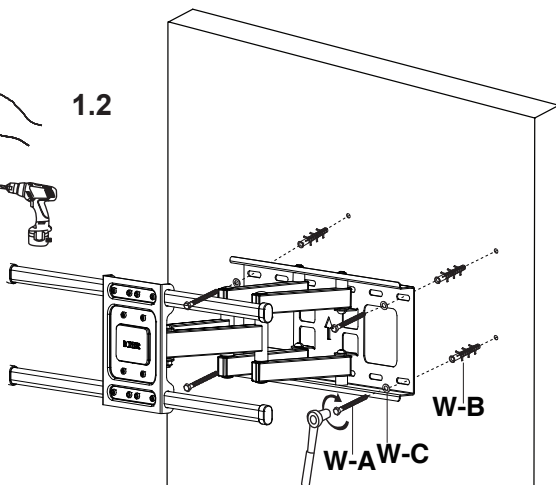
Step 2 Mounting the Wall Plate to the Wall

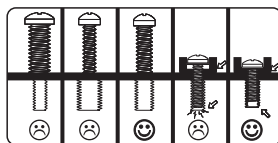
Step 3 Install VESA Plate to the back of TV

For Flat screen TV

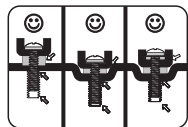

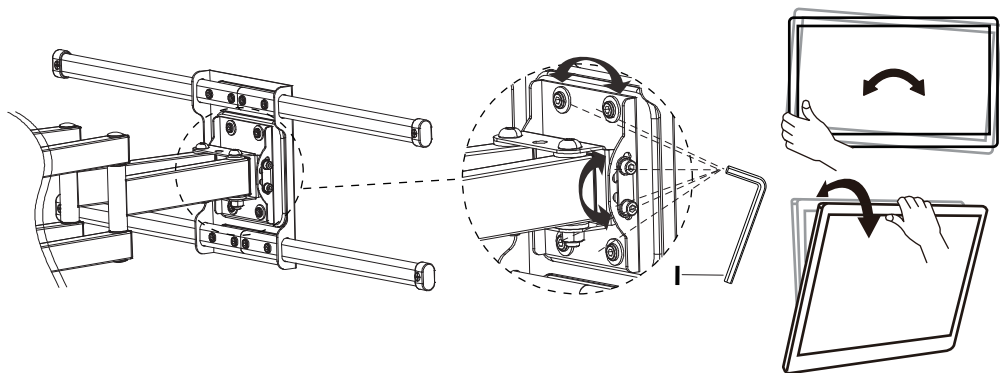


Step 4 Final Installation
